The event is open to the general public for a full weekend of fun for the whole family, beginning Saturday, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., and Sunday, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Admission is free. This year's highlights include two daily battles at 11:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m., authentic living history campsites and a period field hospital. Live period music will be provided by The Slackjaw Brothers, and Occasional Strings.

Each year's event has proven to be even bigger and better than the last, and this year will be no exception with over twelve reenacting companies from all over Southern California taking the field with upwards of 300 reenactors, mounted cavalry, cannons, food and merchandise vendors and the biggest period Lady's Tea this side of the Mississippi.
